Description	Aga Khan Foundation Canada (AKFC) is a non-profit international development agency, working in Asia and Africa to find sustainable solutions to the complex problems causing global poverty. AKFC concentrates on a number of specific development challenges in health, education, rural development and civil society. In Canada, AKFC raises funds, builds partnerships with Canadian institutions, and promotes discussion and learning on international development issues. Established in 1980, AKFC is a registered Canadian charity and an agency of the worldwide Aga Khan Development Network. Focus Humanitarian Assistance (FOCUS) Pakistan is the lead implementing agency for humanitarian assistance of the AKDN in Pakistan, and draws upon extensive experience in disaster management and response. FOCUS began its operations in Pakistan in mid 90s when the country was challenged by the huge influx of Afghan refugees. Approximately 43,000 members of the Afghan community were facilitated by FOCUS in repatriation. In 1999, FOCUS began its Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) Programme with the name Preparedness, Mitigation & Prevention (PMP) with four strategic goals including (a) DRR (b) Disaster Response (c) IDP & Refugee Assistance and (d) Institutional Strengthening. The DRR encompasses the components of Hazard Vulnerability and Risk Assessments (HVRA), Community Based Disaster Risk Management (CBDRM) and School Safety Programme (SFP). The Community Emergency Response Teams (CERTs) for an organized and effective response capitalizing on the voluntary spirit amongst communities. To date as part of the CBDRM component FOCUS has established 152 CERTs with about 35,000 trained community volunteers on basic disaster response skills. The community preparedness is also supplemented with the provision of over 88 community stockpiles in the remote areas. These CERTs have responde to numerous local natural disasters. Position Description

The Resource Mobilisation Officer will be responsible for supporting the Senior Programme Officer – Disaster Risk Management in drafting reports and project proposals, assist in implementing a long-term resource mobilisation strategy and action plan, improving the internal and external reporting and documentation and gathering information on donor policies and priorities. S/he will also work closely with the Communication Officer and the Programme team members on specific case studies, success stories, publications and research projects aligned with the mandate and strategy of FOCUS Pakistan.

Specific Objectives include:

- Build capacity in local unit resources in the area of Resource Mobilisation.
- Support the building of a strong network of international donor funding.
- Liaise with donors keeping in view FOCUS funding strategies, practices and principles of other partner AKDN agencies.
- Researching grants related to disaster management, enhancing communities' resilience, climate change etc.

Key Responsibilities include:

- Provide research and advisory support to the Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) Programme.
- Formulate successful concept notes and proposals aligned with FOCUS' mandate and strategy.
- Develop capacity of the local staff by conducting training on report, proposal and grant writing.
- Ensure follow-up on submitted funding proposals, liaise with donors, and incorporate changes and comments.
- Support the implementation of a long-term resource mobilisation strategy.
- Help improve internal and external documentation.
- Provide programmatic support to management.
- Coordinate, liaise and develop close relationship with key stakeholders, working in the field of disaster risk management.
- Assist with the development and strengthening of relationships with International development agencies in the region.
- Prepare presentations for governments and donors on potential FOCUS projects and programmes in order to generate interest.

In all activities, the Resource Mobilisation Officer will work closely with all relevant program and communication staff.
