The Quebec **Breast Cancer** Screening Program (PQDCS) recommends that all

women aged 50 to 69 have a mammogram every 2 years.

## **BREAST CANCER** SIGNS

X A palpable mass on breast X Nipples are turned inward instead of outward Kernel Fluid comes out of the nipple X Skin on the nipple looks or feels different (for example, it may look like eczema but does not get better) Skin texture on breast looks

like an orange peel

Kin over one third or more

of a breast becomes red

# PAPANICOLAOU (PAP) TEST

- Did you know that a PAP test is a procedure in which cells from the opening of the cervix is taken with a swab?
- This will determine if there are any abnormal cells in the cervix.
- The test is effective for cervical cancer screening and takes only a few minutes.

Women should have this test every 2 to 3 years. WHERE TO ACCESS THE PAP TEST?
