Who can apply? Immigrant women who:

- Are Permanent residents of Canada
- Are willing to work in a store for at least 6 months
- Are at a Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) level of 3 or 4
- Have no more than 12 years of schooling

- Transit passes are provided
