Childcare Training for Low Literacy Immigrant Women assists low literacy immigrant women obtain a Child Development Assistant Certificate

### The purpose of the program:

*To help immigrant women to:*

- Work in Canada
- Improve English
- Gain work skills
- Get Level 1 daycare certificate
- Find employment in a Canadian daycare

### Who can apply?

- Women with 0-7 years of education in home country
- Canadian Language Benchmarks (CLB) 2- 4 in listening / speaking & 1- 3 in reading / writing
- Be an Albertan resident
- Permanent Residents, Canadian citizens or convention refugees

### Other details:

- Free training
- Childcare expenses (Funding application approval)
- Low income (Available funding)
- No funding guarantee. Government decision.

36 weeks of in-class training  
8 weeks of work experience
