Dear Generations Calgary Community and Supporters,

As part of our ongoing communication related to COVID-19, I would like to provide an update on behalf of Generations Calgary.

I am pleased to report that as of February 10, 2021, all residents have received both doses of the COVID vaccine. This is a significant milestone in the protection that it provides our residents against the risk of infection and serious illness, and we extend deep appreciation to our partners at Alberta Health Services and all those involved in the vaccination process for their work in ensuring the protection of our most vulnerable.

With the continued implementation of the vaccination roll-out plan, we anticipate that our staff and those who provide direct support and services to our residents will complete their vaccinations in the coming weeks.

We are also pleased to report that we have not had any resident or staff active COVID-19 cases since the end of January 2021.

We continue to remain vigilant in the face of the continued dangers of the virus, particularly in light of the potentially heightened risks of the variant strains. In addition to the enhanced health and safety measures that we took with our residents and staff in early March 2020, we have continued to bolster our infection containment steps, including remaining disciplined and rigorous with screening and PPE measures.

I am particularly grateful to our staff team, led by Park Place Seniors Living, for their sacrifice, care and effort to keep our residents healthy and safe. From the leadership team to all nurses, healthcare aides, recreation, hospitality, housekeeping, maintenance and administration teams, each person has gone above and beyond to ensure that resident care is our top priority.

I would also like to thank the *Generations* Calgary Board, Management Committee, and volunteers for their continuous commitment. It is their dedication that makes *Generations* Calgary a leader in delivering community-based and volunteer supported multi-generational housing to the broader community.

We are truly thankful for the partnership and support of our residents and families, without which none of this progress would have been possible. We pray for the good health and safety of the entire Generations community, and for all those affected by these challenging times.
