ECONOMIC IMPACT

From an economic standpoint, the COVID-19 outbreak has resulted in a period of significant uncertainty and volatility, with equity markets recently experiencing one of the sharpest declines since 2008. In light of this, we offer the following perspectives:

- Canada will experience a technical recession in 2020, as economic activity contracts in the second and third quarters of the year. The slowdown will limit growth for all of 2020 to 0.2%, a sharp decline from growth of 1.6% last year. Forecasts for the U.S., Europe and the U.K. are also weaker.
- Central banks will take further aggressive action to support financial conditions. Government will also take action, though the magnitude and timing are as yet unclear.
- Job losses in Canada, particularly in highly exposed sectors, will occur but will prove temporary. Falling oil prices will hit the energy sector harder.

•

- Low interest rates constitute favorable news for those carrying debt on lines of credit, mortgages and floating rate loans. It will help ease interest burden. The Canadian government is reviewing a range of potential measures to help the public
- It is expected that the impact of the coronavirus will fade after the end of the first half, though low oil prices will constrain Canada's recovery for the rest of the year.
