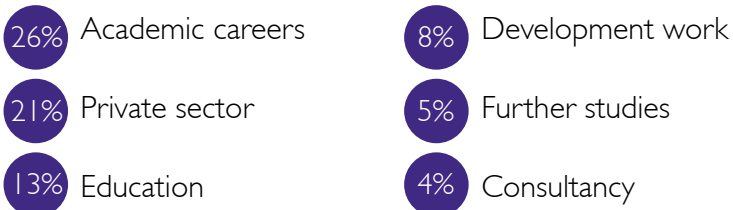
The Institute of Ismaili Studies is inviting applications for its flagship programme, the **Graduate Programme in Islamic Studies and Humanities** (GPISH).
