Canva is a free graphic design platform that allows users to create social media graphics, presentations, posters and other visual content. It offers many professional designed templates that can be edited, and integrates millions of images, fonts, templates and illustrations.

Graphic design is more objective than subjective; it involves putting the end user's priorities ahead of personal creative preferences. You always design for the user, not yourself.
