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Entry level work placement is available in different areas such as:

Office Administration - Human Resources - IT - Engineering - Financial Analysis - Accounting - Marketing - Non-Profit - Health Care etc.

This program offers:

- 14 weeks of pre-employment skill-building workshops
- long-term employment counselling and individualized career planning support
- assistance creating a 5 year career plan
- 10 weeks of Canadian work experience
- mentorship from a professional immigrant woman
- compensation for childcare and transportation costs

Eligible for mothers:

- between 15-30 years of age
- have Permanent Resident status
- unemployed or underemployed
- have a Canadian Language Benchmark score of 5 or higher
